autumn update 2010

Welcome to EllenorLions Hospices Autumn Update. In this issue we look at the many ways you can support us and help your local hospice.

Our care, provided completely free of charge to over 2,500 children and adults each year, takes place in an environment to suit the patient. This may be our 15-bed hospice or in the patient's own home through our dedicated hospice at home team.

We also have a team of nurses in Darent Valley Hospital providing care and support to our patients and professional staff. For teenagers we provide a pioneering transition support service which ensures that young people have their needs acknowledged and that the appropriate care and support is available for them and their families. We also provide day care and various complementary therapies.

This all encompassing palliative care will cost £4,800,000 this year to provide. We must raise the bulk of this from our fundraising activities. These activities are as diverse as our care and include events put on by our supporters.

EllenorLions Hospices - What can you do to help?



Alan Nugent has been a patient with EllenorLions Hospices since February 2010. He was diagnosed with Pseudonmyxoma Peritonei (PP), a rare form of cancer affecting the abdomen.
